VOTER INFORMATION

Qualifications for Voting

To register and vote in Travis County you must be...

1. a citizen of the United States, a resident of Travis County
2. at least 18 years old on the day of the election
3. not declared mentally incompetent by a court of law
4. not a convicted felon, or, if so convicted you have:
 - a) fully discharged your sentence, including any term of incarceration, parole, supervision, or completed a period of probation ordered by any court; or
 - b) been pardoned or otherwise released from any disability to vote.

Voter Registration

Texas has a year round permanent voter registration system. There is no fee to register. Once registered, a voter receives a color-coded certificate (card) mailed mid-November through early December of odd-numbered years. It will specify the two year period for which it is valid. Current certificates, valid through 12/31/2007, are yellow.

When to register

Register at least 30 days before an election in order to vote in that election. You must re-register each time you move, whether it is within the county or to or from another county. The post office does not forward voter registration certificates.

How to Register

You may register by mail or in person at the office of the Travis County Tax Assessor-Collector, 5501 Airport Blvd, Austin, Monday-Friday, 7:30 a.m.-5:30 p.m. or through an authorized Volunteer Deputy Registrar. The Texas Department of Public Safety also registers voters as they apply for or renew their driver's licenses or Texas identification cards. All applicants must sign a registration card. Additional identification is required for first time voters. College students should register where they intend to vote, either at college or in their home town. For information on obtaining a postage-paid, mail-in application, contact Voter Registration by phone at 854-9473 or at www.traviscountytax.org. The completed application must be received by the Travis County registrar 30 days prior to an election. Mail-in applications are often available at post offices, libraries, and some stores.

Voting

Voting on election day takes place at precinct polling locations. Your voter registration certificate lists your precinct number and the newspaper normally lists county polling places by precinct number on election day. You are entitled to assistance in voting if you are blind, physically disabled, unable to read or write, or unable to speak to the election judges in English.
